Home Learning Ideas

Below are some ideas based around our new topic. Please read the ideas to your child and let them choose which activities they would like to complete at home with you or on their own. Try to complete at least 2 activities and make sure you bring your home learning in throughout the half term so that it can be displayed.

Roman Numerals

- Discover how the Romans represented their numbers and create a poster explaining them.
- Find out your families dates of birth and write them in Roman Numerals.

Roman Empire and the Army

- Create a timeline of how the Roman Empire expanded from Rome to Britain.
- Create a map of countries that were part of the Roman Empire.
- Write a letter as a Roman Soldier to their family. They didn't have paper, what could you write it on?
- What type of equipment did Roman Soldiers have? Choose a piece of equipment and make it out of cardboard and other materials.
- Create a model of an iconic Roman building using junk modelling, Lego or other materials you have around your house.
- Find out if there were any Roman settlements local to where you live.

Gods and Goddesses

- Research the Roman Gods and Goddesses. How are these different to the Greeks? What was the Roman god of war called?
- Create a fact file about a Roman God or Goddess.
