The Greatest Showman Home Learning Ideas



Below are some ideas based around our new topic. Please read the ideas to your child and let them choose which activities they would like to complete at home with you or on their own. Try to complete at least 2 activities and make sure you bring your home learning in throughout the half term so that it can be displayed.

Topic

- Why not have a go at setting up your own circus at home. You could dress up as a clown and have a go at some circus skills yourself. Can you juggle? What about stilt walking or hula hopping? Have you ever tried spinning plates?
- Create a lego masterpiece—from a Big Top Tent to Hogwarts' Castle. What will you create?
- Are you the greatest showman? Put on a top hat and become a magician. What magic
 tricks will you conjure up? Can you make something disappear? Do you know any really
 cool card tricks?
- Create your own circus advertisement inspired by those created for P.T Barnum's
 Circus.

Science

- Make a list of all of the things in your home that use electricity? How many things can you find? Who can make the longest list?
- Create a poster to remind your family to turn electrical items off when they are not being used such as turning off the lights when you're not in the room and turning off the tv when it's not being watched.
- Find a way to create your own static electricity.
- Create your own light up wizard wands.
- Find out what conducts electricity by collecting common objects such as a key, chalk, wood and a candle. Then, test each object by putting it between a battery and a light bulb and touching foil to the base of the bulb. If the bulb lights up, the object conducts electricity!
