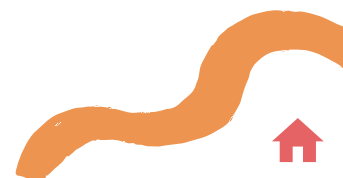

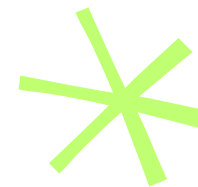

A range of summer activities are offered, which must be booked in advance.

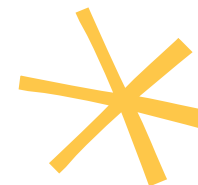
