In our final topic this year, we will be looking at the qualities/traits that Superheroes have and how they use their super skills to help us.

Maths

Maths in our final term will consolidate the children's general arithmetic skills of addition and subtraction, within 20. We will also introduce the measurements of money and time.

Please continue to play NumBots at home, it would be wonderful to see some children achieving their diamond award this term.

Science

This half-term in Science we will be revisiting the topic 'Everyday Materials'. The children will learn about the uses and properties of different everyday materials.



PSHE/RE/PE

PSHE – All our PSHE learning this half-term will be around the theme 'Growing and Changing'.

RE – Which books and stories are important.

PE – Climbing and Athletics (Sports Day preparation).



Writing

This half-term in English we will be exploring the texts Supertato by Sue Hendra and A Superhero Like You by Dr Ranj. We will use these texts to consolidate our learning this year. We will use 'think it, say it, write it, check it' to write stories containing a range of interesting adjectives, punctuation and suffixes.

Reading/Phonics

This half-term it will be the National Phonics Screening Check in Y1. The check will take place on w/c Monday 9th June 2025. Our daily phonics sessions will continue and every day counts so please make sure you keep up your good attendance! We will continue to develop our reading fluency and become more confident in answering simple comprehension questions about the texts we read. Please continue to practise your phonics and reading skills at home to help your child prepare.

Topic

Art and Design – Draw a superhero identity self-portrait. Study the work of Roy Lichtenstein artist and create some Pop Art.

Design Technology – Design, make and evaluate a fruit kebab.

History – This topic explores the lives and achievements of Florence Nightingale and Mary Seacole, who transformed nursing. We will learn about their contributions to history, how they changed the world, and how their lives compare to each other and to today.

Key Vocabulary – nurse, hygiene, hospital, war, pioneer, legacy
