This half term we will be completing our unit on addition and subtraction, consolidating our understanding and application of the formal written methods.

Our second unit will focus on multiplication and division. Recapping the use of arrays before learning to multiply and divide by 2, 5, 10, 3, 4 and 8.

Our TTRS focus will be the twos and fives.
Play regularly at home to increase your times table fluency!



#### Reading Club

This half term we will be looking at both fiction and non-fiction texts we will continue to build our comprehension skills of vocabulary, inference, retrieval, explain and summarise.

## About this topic

Our topic this half term is 'From Stones to Swords' and we can't wait to get immersed in the Stone Age!

They will be creating art work in the style of cave drawings and will be attempting to make tools, make shelters and perhaps even cook cave-man style.

### Topic

Art – Investigating and recreating primitive cave art with a particular focus on cave paintings from Lascaux, France and the use of natural pigments such as charcoal and other.

History – The Stone Age to The Iron Age.
This topic explores how life in Britain
changed from the Stone Age (when early
humans lived as hunter-gatherers) to the
Iron Age (when advanced farming, metal
tools, and hill forts became common). It
includes studying the development of
communities, technology, culture, and daily
life.

PE – In PE this half term for indoor PE Year
3 will either be climbing or completing a
gymnastics unit. In outdoor PE will be
focusing on ball skills.
