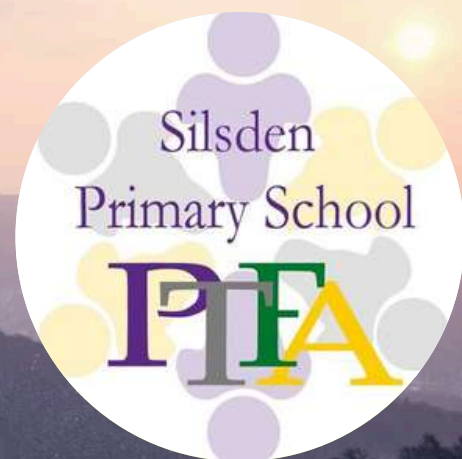

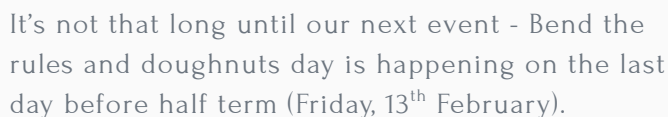

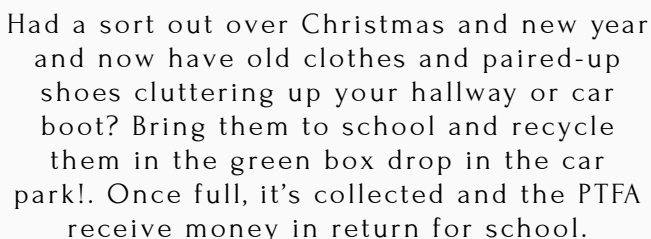


RECYCLE OLD CLOTHES AT SCHOOL

What have your donations funded so far?



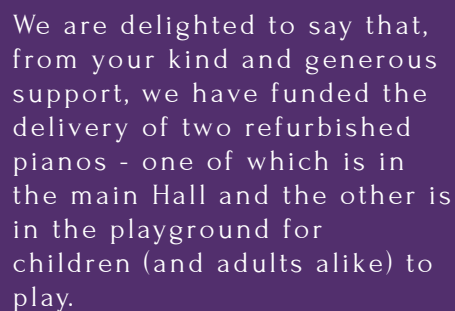
