

Year 5 Bradford Industrial Museum Visit

9th January 2026

Dear Parents/Carers

As part of our history curriculum, over the next half term we will be looking at the lives of Victorian children in Britain and the impact of the Industrial Revolution. We will be visiting the Industrial Museum in Bradford to give the children a hands-on experience as to what life was like. Children will take part in a re-enactment of a Victorian schoolroom and complete a weaving workshop. There may also be an opportunity for them to walk around some of the museum.

The visit will take place on Tuesday 10th February (Wilberforce and Pankhurst) and Wednesday 11th February (Churchill). Children will need to arrive at school promptly as the bus will be leaving at 9.00am, this is to allow us time to get to Bradford through the morning traffic and arrive at 10.00am. We should return to school for 3.30pm. The cost of the trip is **£18.00**, this is a voluntary contribution, however if we do not receive enough monies, the trip will not take place. The price includes transport, insurance and workshops led by staff from the Industrial Museum.

Children will need to bring a packed lunch in a bag that they are able to carry around for the day, so a rucksack is preferable. **No glass bottles or fizzy drinks.** If your child would like a school packed lunch, please complete the form before Monday 26th January - [Y5 Packed lunch form](#)

As we are visiting a Victorian Museum, it would be good if the children can come dressed in period costume. Due to the time of year, and our changing weather, children will need to have a warm coat appropriate for cold and wet days as we will be spending some time outside.

We would also be grateful if any parent/carer/grandparent would be able to offer to accompany us for the day. If you are available, then please can you let one of the teachers know or contact the school office.

If your child uses an inhaler or has any other medical requirements, please ensure that they have all the things they need with them on the day.

We are looking forward to a really exciting day.
