Romans



Below are some ideas based around our new topic. Please read the ideas to your child and let them choose which activities they would like to complete at home with you or on their own.

Topic:

- Can you discover how the Romans represented their numbers and create a poster explaining them?
- Create a map of the countries part of the Roman empire.
- What type of equipment did Roman soldiers have? Choose a piece of equipment and make it out of cardboard or other materials.
- Create a model of an iconic Roman building using junk modelling, LEGO, or other materials you have in your house.
- Find out if there were any Roman settlements local to where you live. Research about it and create a fact file.
- Create a fact file about a Roman God or Goddess.
- Make a mosaic picture using paper squares (Romans loved mosaics!)

Science:

- Draw and label parts of a flowering plant (roots, stem, leaves, petals).
- Make a 3D flower model using paper or recycled materials.
- Create a collage showing different types of flowers.
- Plant seeds (beans or cress) and watch them grow.
