

Dear Parents

We are fast approaching our fantastic trip to Northumberland.

To help with organisation, we are providing a kit list – they won't need much, it's only one night!

To keep it simple, they will need to be wearing one set of clothes and the others are spares 'in case'.

Clothes	Toothbrush and tooth paste
A waterproof coat	Facecloth and towel
Sturdy trainers	Water bottle
A spare pair of shoes – also suitable for walking outdoors in case one pair gets wet – check forecast for probability	Small rucksack – to carry day kit eg hat, suncream, pencil, activity sheets, <u>water bottle</u>
Socks – one on and one fresh pair	Reading book
Underpants – 2 pairs (just in case!)	Maximum of £10 for the shop in a named purse. They will be responsible for it at all times!
Tee shirt	A hat for sun protection
Fleece	A teddy - perhaps not their very most special one just in case!
Shorts and/or trackies	Nightwear – pyjamas

They **must not bring electronic toys of any kind or phones.**

Packed lunch for the day of departure. Please consider carefully the likelihood of spillages and bursts - no yoghurts or fizzy drinks please.

We have suggested a maximum of £10 to spend in the gift shop in Vindolanda - please don't feel obliged to give them the full amount. They will be encouraged to choose something which is specific to Romans! Their purses need to be kept in their rucksacks.

If your child requires any prescribed medication during the trip, please collect a medical form from the school office in advance. If your child suffers with travel sickness, please ensure they have a tablet in the

morning. School staff can only administer prescribed travel sickness medication for the return journey. **All medications should be clearly labelled with your child's name and handed to Mrs Dent on the day of departure.**

All adults will have their phones and will be contactable if necessary. We will let you know that we have arrived safely.

On Tuesday 19th May please can children arrive at school for 8.30am and come through the Small Hall. On Wednesday 20th we hope to arrive back at school by 4.30pm but this is obviously determined by the traffic we meet. We will keep school and parents informed of our timings.
