

Y3 TRIP INFORMATION

HARIAN'S WALL VISIT – Tuesday 19th May - Wednesday 20th May

ARRIVAL: All children attending the Y3 residential **should arrive at school promptly at 8:30am**. Please enter school through the small hall doors to drop off your overnight bag/suitcase. Parents/Carers should hand over any medication to Mrs Dent who will be in the small hall at this time.

WHAT TO WEAR: **Children should come to school in clothes suitable for the outdoors**. For example, a pair of jogging bottoms/leggings, a t-shirt, a jumper/hoodie, a waterproof coat and suitable/sturdy walking shoes or trainers. Wellies will not be suitable.

PACKING: **Children will need two bags. One overnight bag/suitcase and one day rucksack**. Please see what should be packed in each bag below. Please note children must not bring any additional toys from home or electronics/phones of any kind.

We are aware that some children wear pull ups at night. If this is the case for your child, please let their class teacher know so that we can support them to deal with it. Provide them with a bag to dispose of them in and ensure they know that they cannot be flushed!

Overnight Bag:

- A change of clothes for the next day. These also need to be suitable for the outdoors. (See suggestions above)
- A jumper/hoodie/fleece
- Two pairs of underwear
- Two pairs of socks
- A spare pair of suitable/sturdy shoes for walking
- Pyjamas
- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Facecloth
- Towel
- A teddy
- A reading book

Day Rucksack (This needs to be a bag that the children can carry on their back.):

- Waterproof coat
- Refillable water bottle
- Packed Lunch (If you have ordered one from school, your child should collect this from the small hall on arrival. If you haven't ordered one, please ensure you provide one. Please avoid packing things which are likely to spill/leak (e.g. yogurts, fizzy drinks etc.)
- Sun hat
- Suncream
- Pocket money (A maximum of £10 in a named purse. Children will be responsible for their own money. Please don't feel obliged to give them the full amount. Children will be encouraged to choose something which is specific to Romans.)

RETURN TO SCHOOL: **We hope to arrive back by 4.30pm on Wednesday 20th May** but this is obviously determined by the traffic we meet. We will keep school and parents informed of our timings.

KEEPING YOU UP TO DATE: We will let you know we have arrived safely. We will update the school Facebook page with photos, where possible.
