Maths

This half-term in Maths we will be introducing the children to numbers to 100. We will begin by working on place value and how two-digit numbers are formed before moving on to addition and subtraction skills. Later in the half term we will be looking at recognising coins and notes in our money unit before moving on to time, looking specially at o'clock and half past.

Please continue to keep playing Numbots regular at home to embed knowledge taught in the classroom.



English

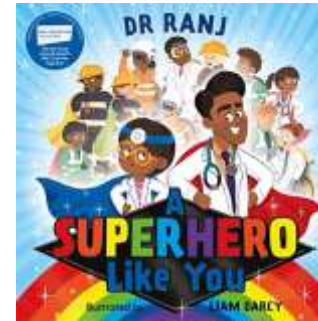

Through exploring both of these texts the children will work towards using their knowledge of conjunctions and adjectives to write their own descriptions of superhero jobs and a wanted poster for the Evil Pea!

With the phonics screening taking place this half term, we will be working hard to build and consolidate our phonetic knowledge through our daily phonics sessions. To support learning at home please focus on the Common Exception Word for Year 1.
