You could-

Find some fun facts about pirates that we can all learn and create your very own fact poster to share with us in class. Build your own pirate ship, can it float in your bath or sink? Make a delicious treasure map pizza, don't forget X marks the spot.

Create a wanted poster to help capture a dangerous pirate. Create your own pirate hat, to help you become a real-life pirate. Can you create a matching eye-patch too?

Create your own pirate flag.

Write a message in a bottle for a pirate.

Create and decorate your own treasure chest.

Make a pirate puppet and re-tell a pirate story.

Create a parrot to sail the seven seas with a pirate crew!
