Year 4 Specific Messages

Year 3 Specific Messages

READING RECORDS AND BOOKS - Please could children bring in their reading records, library books and reading books to school every day. This is particularly necessary on a Friday when children will be awarded for if they've read 3 or more times in a week. 3 reads or more warrants a move up and 5 reads or more warrants a house point.
